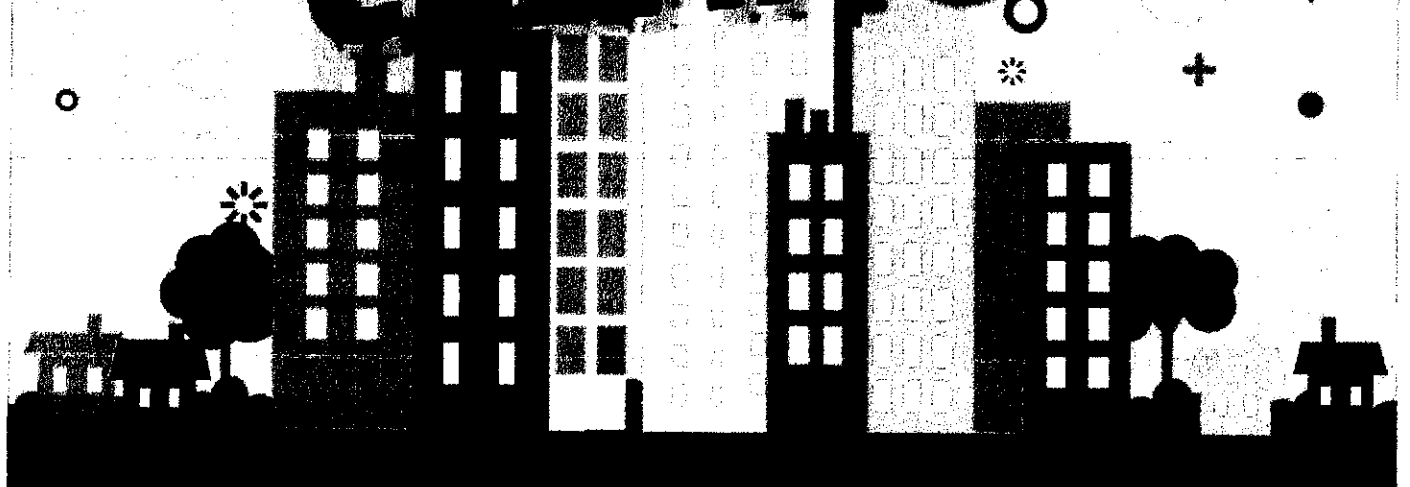

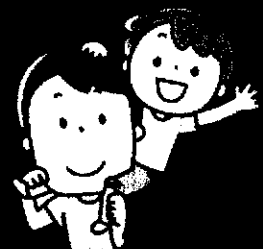
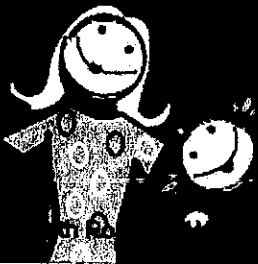

Option 1: paint fence

Landscape fabric - \$100

Native hardwood mulch, 2" deep - 398
(includes tax and delivery fee);

Get rid of weeds and plant drought resistant plants or wait to plant until a later date.

Option 2: paint fence

Landscape fabric - \$100

White rock, 2" deep 720

(Does not include tax and \$135 delivery fee)

Get rid of weeds and plant or not plant at same time

Plants that are there at present: Yaupon Holly, China Roses, Trumpet Vine
