The Board of Alderman of the Village of Jones Creek, Texas held a City Council Special Called Meeting on Wednesday, May 12th, 2021 at the Village Hall located at 7207 Stephen F. Austin Road, within the incorporated limits of said Village beginning at 6:30 p.m. Members of the public could attend the meeting in person or via teleconference.
