CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL CALLED MEETING

The Board of Alderman of the Village of Jones Creek, Texas held a City Council Special Called Meeting on Monday, March 23, 2020 at the Village Hall located at 7207 Stephen F. Austin Road, within the incorporated limits of said Village beginning at 5:00 p.m., the subject of said meeting being as follows:

SUPPLEMENTAL NOTICE OF MEETING BY TELEPHONE CONFERENCE:

In accordance with order of the Office of the Governor issued March 16, 2020, the Board of Alderman of the Village of Jones Creek conducted the meeting scheduled at 5:00 p.m. at City Hall by telephone conference in order to consider matters directly related to the Coronavirus ("COVID-19") pandemic, advance the public health goal of limiting face-to-face meetings (also called "social distancing"), and to slow the spread of the Coronavirus (COVID-19). [There was no public access to the location described above.]

The public was permitted to offer public comments telephonically by a toll-free dial-in number as provided by the agenda and as permitted by the presiding officer during the meeting. City Council members participated by telephone under Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code.

3. ROLL CALL OF MEMBERS *The following members were present via teleconference: Mayor Gordon Schlemmer, Alderman Glenn Jordan, Alderman Terry Jeffers, Alderman Corey Thomas, Alderwoman Nicole Hardesty, and Alderman Justin Wright.*

4. BUSINESS OF VISITORS (limited to five minutes per person) *An announcement of a future special called meeting to discuss the Daniel Krampota, et al v. The Village of Jones Creek, Texas, et al lawsuit was stated by City Secretary/Administrator Kimberly Morris.*


5. DISCUSSION/POSSIBLE ACTION
