

Minutes,
June 19, 2018

The Village of Jones Creek Board of Aldermen held a regular meeting on Tuesday, June 19th, 2018 at 6:30 p.m. The following members were present; Mayor Gordon Schlemmer, Terry Jeffers, Glenn Jordan, Rocky Thomas, AJ Jinkins, and Mr. Mike Chilcote.

The invocation was given by Mr. Mark Miles.

The pledge to the flag was said by all.

Mr. Mark Miles spoke under business of visitors providing council with words of wisdom and encouragement.

The Minutes of May 15th, 2018 were accepted as presented after a motion and second were heard from Mr. Rocky Thomas and Mr. Mike Chilcote. All were in favor and motion carried.

Monthly reports were accepted by a motion from Mr. Terry Jeffers, and a second from Mr. Glenn Jordan. All were in agreement, motion carried.

Mr. Mike Chilcote made a motion to appoint Cindy Zinnell to a one year term as Municipal Judge. Mr. AJ Jinkins seconded the motion, all were in favor, and motion carried.

Mr. Rocky Thomas made the motion to close regular session and go into executive session at 6:32 p.m. With a second from Mr. Glenn Jordan, motion passed.

Motion to resume regular session was heard from Mr. Rocky Thomas at 6:58 p.m. With a second from Mr. AJ Jinkins, motion carried.

Mr. Rocky Thomas made a motion to place the city owned bank property on Highway 36 up for a minimum bid of \$85,000.00. Mr. Glenn Jordan seconded the motion, all were in favor, and motion carried.

Council was briefed and discussed the need for fire marshal inspections. Mr. Glenn Jordan made a motion to table the item until an ordinance or resolution could be drafted and presented to council. Mr. AJ Jinkins seconded the motion, all members were in favor and motion carried.

Further discussion on drainage issues was postponed until new information becomes available by a motion and second from Mr. AJ Jinkins and Mr. Rocky Thomas. All members voted for and the motion carried.

Council was presented a petition requesting annexation by area landowners. Mr. AJ Jinkins made a motion to accept the petition and begin annexation proceedings, with a second from Mr. Glenn Jordan. All members were in favor, and motion carried.

Mr. Glenn Jordan excused himself from the meeting at 7:15 p.m. due to work obligations.

Mr. Rocky Thomas made a motion to table discussion on mowing of city properties so that he could make inquires and bring information back to council. Mr. Terry Jeffers seconded the motion, all were in favor, and motion carried.

Concerns in regards to heavy haul items being placed out to street after pick up has occurred was discussed and considered by council. Mr. Rocky Thomas made a motion to direct staff to place public awarness information about heavy haul on the city's website, facebook page, and communication system. Mr. Mike Chilcote seconded the motion, all members were in favor, and motion carried.

After a lengthy discussion between residents and city council, Mr. Terry Jeffers made a motion to not include peacocks in the bird sanctuary ordinance. Mr. Rocky Thomas seconded the motion. Three members vote for and Mr. AJ Jinkins voted nay. Motion carried by majority vote.
