

Minutes,
November 21, 2017

The Village of Jones Creek Board of Aldermen held a regular meeting on Tuesday, November 21st, 2017 at 6:30 p.m. The following members were present; Mayor Gordon Schlemmer, Terry Jeffers, Glenn Jordan, Rocky Thomas, AJ Jinkins, and Mike Chilcote.

The invocation was given by Brother Brent Pittman of the Jones Creek Baptist Church.

The pledge to the flag was said by all.

Marshal William Tidwell spoke under business advising council that the Jones Creek Christmas in the Creek would be held on December 14th; also, that he is still working on getting information on paper shredding; and, regular trash service would be done on Friday due to Thanksgiving Day.

The Minutes of October 17th, 2017 were accepted as presented after a motion and second were heard from Mr. Glenn Jordan and Mr. Rocky Thomas. All were in favor and motion carried.

Monthly reports were accepted by a motion from Mr. Terry Jeffers, and a second from Mr. Mike Chilcote. All were in agreement, motion carried.

Mr. Rocky Thomas made a motion to table consideration of landscaping requirements until after the holidays and more research can be done. Mr. AJ Jinkins seconded the motion, all were in favor, and the motion carried.

Council deliberated on quotes for lawn tractors. Mr. Rocky Thomas made the motion to purchase a 3000 Series Toro 60” in the amount of \$7839.36 with a second from Mr. Mike Chilcote. Four members vote for, Mr. Glenn Jordan voted nay, and motion carried.

Mr. Rocky Thomas made a motion to sell by bid a 2008 Crown Victoria Police Unit for a minimum bid of \$1000. Mr. Glenn Jordan seconded the motion, all were in favor, and motion carried.

Mr. Mike Chilcote made a motion to table discussions on leasing bank signage on Highway 36, with a seconded from Mr. Glenn Jordan. All members were in favor and motion carried.

Mr. Rocky Thomas made a motion to table further discussions in regards to drainage issues until her could arrange a meeting with Drainage Commissioner Doyle Bennett. MR. Mike Chilcote seconded the motion, all were in favor, and motion carried.

After a lengthy discussion in regards to debris removal for the flood impacted area Mr. AJ Jinkins made a motion to allow Mayor Gordon Schlemmer to negotiate for the removal of the remaining storm related debris. Mr. Rocky Thomas seconded the motion, all were in favor, and motion carried.
