

Minutes,
September 19, 2017

The Village of Jones Creek Board of Aldermen held a regular meeting on Tuesday, September 19th, 2017 at 6:30 p.m. The following members were present; Mayor Gordon Schlemmer, Terry Jeffers, Glenn Jordan, Rocky Thomas, AJ Jinkins, and Mike Chilcote.

The invocation was given by Mayor Gordon Schlemmer.

The pledge to the flag was said by all.

It was announced under business of visitors that the Jones Creek Volunteer Fire Department's Annual BBQ and Auction has been moved to October 28th, 2017 to the Jones Creek Baptist Church due to Hurricane Harvey. Appreciation to all the volunteers during the Hurricane and flooding was expressed by council.

The Minutes of August 22nd, 2017, Emergency Called Meeting of September 1st, 2017, and minutes to the Special Called Meeting of September 12th, 2017, were accepted as presented after a motion and second were heard from Mr. Terry Jeffers and Mr. Rocky Thomas. All were in favor and motion carried.

Monthly reports were accepted by a motion from Mr. Glenn Jordan, and a second from Mr. Terry Jeffers. All were in agreement, motion carried.

Mr. Rocky Thomas made a motion to approve an Ordinance Levying Taxes for the 2017/2018 Fiscal Year, with a second from Mr. Terry Jeffers. All were in favor, and motion carried.

Mr. Terry Jeffers made a motion to approve an Interlocal agreement between Brazoria County and the Village of Jones Creek for mobile computer terminals and computer aided dispatch software. Mr. Mike Chilcote seconded the motion, all members were in favor, and motion carried.

Council held a discussion between themselves, Marshal William Tidwell, and the public in regards to the recovery efforts from the Brazos and San Bernard River Flooding due to Hurricane Harvey. No action was taken at this time.

No addendum from Crowder Gulf was presented. No action taken by council at this time.

Mrs. Diane Howard asked City Council if they would consider selling a portion or all of the property they own on the highway that abuts her property. Mr. Rocky Thomas made a motion to hold a special called meeting on September 27th, 2017 to deliberate on the selling of property. Mr. Mike Chilcote seconded the motion, all were in favor, and motion carried.

A discussion was heard on drainage issues. Council voiced their concern with drainage and it was concluded to reach out to the West of the Brazos Drainage District to see what can be done to help. No further action taken at this time.

Council was informed that Christy Jasek was hired for the full time maintenance position.

A Ford F-150 and a Ford Explorer Police Interceptor were purchased for the Marshal's Department.
