Minutes, August 22, 2017

The Village of Jones Creek Board of Aldermen held a regular meeting on Tuesday, August 22nd, 2017 at 6:30 p.m. The following members were present; Mayor Gordon Schlemmer, Terry Jeffers, Glenn Jordan, Rocky Thomas, AJ Jinkins, and Mike Chilcote.

The invocation was given by Mayor Gordon Schlemmer.

The pledge to the flag was said by all.

Ms. Mildred Matusek addressed council under business of visitors about The Marshal's Office not allowing her grandchildren to ride ATVs or UTVs on the roadways. She also voiced her concern on allowing golf carts on local roadways. Marshal Tidwell advised council of the threat of the remnants of tropical storm Harvey. He instructed that we are making preparations in the event of a storm.

The Minutes of July 18th, 2017 and minutes to the Special Called Meeting of August 10th, 2017, were accepted as presented after a motion and second were heard from Mr. Terry Jeffers and Mr. Rocky Thomas. All were in favor and motion carried.

Monthly reports were accepted by a motion from Mr. Glenn Jordan, and a second from Mr. Terry Jeffers. All were in agreement, motion carried.

Mr. Terry Jeffers made a motion to approve the Amendments as presented to the FY 16/17 Budget, with a second from Mr. Glenn Jordan. All were in favor, and motion carried.

Mr. Rocky Thomas made a motion to close regular session and go into a public hearing for the Fiscal Year 17/18 Budget. Mr. Terry Jeffers seconded the motion, all members were in favor, and motion carried. Members deliberated briefly on the presented FY 17/18 Budget.

Mr. Terry Jeffers made the motion to close the public hearing, with a second from Mr. Rocky Thomas. All were in favor and motion carried.

Mr. Terry Jeffers made a motion to approve the Fiscal Year 17/18 Budget to include the Fiscal Year 16/17 budget amendments previously approved. Mr. AJ Jinkins seconded the motion, all members were in favor, and motion carried.

Mayor Gordon Schlemmer updated council on the process of hiring a new maintenance person. No action taken at this time.

Mayor Schlemmer also advised council about the status of the purchase of two new police units. No action taken at this time.
