

Minutes,
July 18, 2017

The Village of Jones Creek Board of Aldermen and Zoning Board held a joint meeting on Tuesday, July 18th, 2017 at 6:30 p.m. The following members were present; Mayor Gordon Schlemmer, Terry Jeffers, Glenn Jordan, Rocky Thomas, AJ Jinkins, and Mike Chilcote.

The invocation was given by Brother Brent Pittman of the Jones Creek Baptist Church.

The pledge to the flag was said by all.

There was no business of visitors.

The Minutes of June 28th, 2017, were accepted as presented after a motion and second were heard from Mr. Terry Jeffers and Mr. Rocky Thomas. All were in favor and motion carried.

Monthly reports were accepted by a motion from Mr. Glenn Jordan, and a second from Mr. AJ Jinkins. All were in agreement, motion carried.

Mr. Terry Jeffers made a motion to approve a re-plat for lots 1, 2, & 3 of the unrecorded subdivision of block 14 of the Lucy B. Hervey Subdivision, with a second from Mr. Mike Chilcote. All were in favor and motion carried.

Mr. AJ Jinkins made a motion to amend the Vendor, Solicitor, and Peddler Ordinance to include the following: allowing vehicles selling food or food products in a fixed, stationary place to operate during the hours of 4 am to 9 pm, while leaving those conducting soliciting activities door to door to continue to operate during the hours of 9 am to 8 pm; and to add a fee of \$100 per person per 30 day period. Mr. Glenn Jordan seconded the motion, all were in favor, and the motion carried.

Mayor Gordon Schlemmer updated council on current and upcoming drainage projects within the Village of Jones Creek.

Mayor Gordon Schlemmer also advised council that the seller of the 5 acre tract of land decided to take a better offer and would not be selling to the Village of Jones Creek. No further action was taken at this time.

While discussing council's visions or goals for FY 17/18 budget, Mr. Glenn Jordan expressed his desire to see more budgeted funds for building maintenance and updating, and Mr. AJ Jinkins would like sidewalks along Stephen F. Austin if possible. No action was taken at this time.

Mr. Rocky Thomas made the motion to adjourn at 7:06 p.m. With a second from Mr. Mike Chilcote, all were in favor, and motion carried.
