

Minutes,  
July 19, 2016

The Village of Jones Creek Board of Aldermen held a regular meeting on Tuesday, July 19, 2016 at 6:30 p.m. The following members were present; Mayor Gordon Schlemmer, Terry Jeffers, Rocky Thomas, and Glenn Jordan. Jack Taylor and David Doyle were absent.

The invocation was given by Bro. Brent Pittman of the Jones Creek Baptist Church.

The pledge to the flag was said by all.

Marshal William Tidwell spoke under business of visitors informing the board of a Lion's Club being formed in the Village. A letter from John Rice of 410 Peach Point was read to council. Mr. Rice wrote asking the board to consider installing a stop sign at Peach Point Rd and Sailfish to slow traffic.

The Minutes of June 21<sup>st</sup>, 2016 were accepted as presented after a motion and second were heard from Mr. Rocky Thomas and Mr. Terry Jeffers. All were in favor.

Monthly reports were accepted by a motion from Mr. Terry Jeffers, and a second from Mr. Rocky Thomas. All were in agreement, motion carried.

Mr. Glenn Jordan made a motion to approve the Interlocal Agreement with Brazoria County for Mobile Computing Terminals for the Marshal's Office. Mr. Terry Jeffers seconded the motion, all were in favor, and the motion carried.

A motion from Mr. Terry Jeffers was made to approve a resolution allowing General Law Cities to create safe zones. Mr. Glenn Jordan seconded the motion. All were in favor, motion carried.

A brief discussion was heard regarding roof replacement. Hail damage from the May storms was inspected and confirmed by a windstorm adjustor. The Texas Windstorm Insurance Agency has agreed to pay to replace the roof. No action taken at this time.

Mr. Rocky Thomas expressed his concern regarding property maintenance throughout the Village. Marshal Tidwell informed Mr. Thomas and council that he would look into finding remedies to the issues. No action taken.

Mr. Glenn Jordan informed the Board of his concerns for the animal issues within the Village with regards to animals who show signs of aggression. City Secretary Kimberly Morris offered to contact the City Attorney to see if more verbiage could be added to the vicious animal section of the Animal Control Ordinance. No action taken by council.

The Council deliberated on the 2016-2017 Windstorm Insurance Proposal. Mr. Terry Jeffers made the motion to accept the proposal, with a second from Mr. Rocky Thomas. All were in favor and motion carried.

Mr. Rocky Thomas made the motion to adjourn to executive session. Mr. Glenn Jordan seconded the motion, all were in favor, and motion carried.


Mr. Rocky Thomas made the motion to reconvene to regular session. With a second from Mr. Terry Jeffers, motion carried.

No action was taken from executive session.
