New Trash Rules for Jones Creek Residents Inside Village Limits

- 1. Trash pickup will be Thursday of each week; (Please place your container(s) out the evening before. Your container MUST be out no later than 6 a.m. Thursday morning.)
- 2. The bill is due on the 10th of every month. Billing is done on the 20th of every month. (If you become delinquent you will be sent a letter that has futher instructions.)
- 3. Only blue Waste Connection containers should be used;
- 4. No personal containers will be emptied;
- 5. Trash outside container must be bagged and *only* <u>2 bags maximum</u> (this is for one cart account) will be picked up;
- 6. Please bag all your trash for easier pick up and disposal;
- 7. Carts should be placed on level ground as close to the street as possible and the opening of the lid facing the street.
- 8. * Trash payments can be mailed in by check or money order, dropped off in person via check, money order, cash or credit card- with a 3% processing fee. Over the phone with a credit card- with a 3% processing fee, or online at www.payjctx.com (have your account number handy.)
- 9. Heavy trash will be every other week: Schedule attached.
- 10. Heavy Haul items can only be placed next to the street the week prior to pick up)
- 11. Heavy Haul materials must be contained as much as possible, and should be able to fit into the bed of a truck. (ex. bagged, stacked, bundled);
- 12. When doing remodeling or debris cleaning consider renting Roll-off containers through Waste Connections (1-979-864-4600 for more details);

Items that will not be picked up include the following:

- Ammunition
- Asbestos
- Ashes, hot or cold
- Automobile batteries
- Compact fluorescent bulbs & tubes (CFL)
- Dead animals

- Dirt, rocks or concrete
- Electronic waste (computers, TV, and more)
- Household hazardous waste
- Liquid waste like paint
- Medical waste
- Motor oil

- Pharmaceuticals
- Sharps (needles or syringes)
- Tires
- Un-bagged packing pellets or sawdust

Some of these changes are different from our previous trash hauler so please be aware of all changes and adjust your procedures accordingly. This change helps ensure we live in a nicer, cleaner community and assists the hauler with quicker trash collections.

<u> Animal Laws in Jones Creek</u>

- ➤ Animals <u>MUST</u> be registered with the City <u>ANUALLY</u>. (Forms available at City Hall. Must bring current rabies vaccination certificate.)
- ➤ All animals must have rabies vaccinations.
- ➤ Owners are NOT allowed to let their animals roam or run loose at any time.
- Animals must be kept inside an enclosure (fence, house, kennel, etc.) or on a runner.
- ➤ Animals cannot be tethered (tied to tree, staked out, etc.). Animals must be allowed freedom of movement.
- ➤ Owners <u>MUST</u> provide animals with clean water, food, and shelter at all times to ensure proper nutrition.
- ➤ Any animal that makes excessively loud noises or puts off an odor may cause owners to be fined.
- ➤ NO PIG OR SWINE ARE ALLOWED to be owned by any resident in the city.
- ➤ Owners can be fined up to \$2000.00 per day, per violation for any of the above laws.
- ➤ Any animal that attacks a person or another animal, <u>MUST</u> be taken to a veterinarian, quarantined, and tested for rabies. The owner will be responsible for all costs.
- ➤ Animals who have bitten or who have shown signs of aggression may be deemed vicious. Any animal deemed vicious will **NOT** be allowed to be kept or owned within the city.
- **Remember, if you feed a stray animal, by law, it becomes yours and you will be responsible for it. **

The Village of Jones Creek also hosts an Animal Awareness Day annually in the month of May. Half price registration fees, rabies vaccinations and more.
