

Some tips to have a successful heavy haul pick up:

- Your items should be by the road no later than the Friday before heavy haul.

Waiting until the morning of can risk the chance of your haul being missed. Any haul put out AFTER the truck has passed on Saturday will not be picked up until next month.

- Contain, bundle, or bag your piles as much as possible.
- It should be no larger than **two cubic yards**. ie: bed of a truck.
- It should be placed in an area where the claw truck can easily access it and as close to the roadway as possible. (Nothing within a 5-foot radius. ie: mailbox, vehicle, street sign, low hanging tree limbs.)
